3. Requirement

- 1) One (1) Amateur player is allowed to participate from each country/territories.
- Each Association is allowed to select the representative player according to their rules. Any Associations/Federations that hold the Korean Ambassador's Cup shall choose the winner of the competition as the representative player.
- 3) The representative player must have the nationality of the country he/she represents.



4. Tournament Rules

- 6 round Swiss system

Tournament Rules

- Even game, a Dum/Komi of 6.5 points, 40 min each, over time: 30 sec 3 times

- Tournament clocks will be used for all games

- Tie break: WINS > SOS > SOSOS

6. Official Expenses

1) Accommodation

- Full board accommodation will be provided by Korea Baduk Federation (KBF). (* meals to be offered from check-in time of the arrival day to check-out time of the departure day)

Date Sept 8 (after check-in, dinner) - Sept 14 (before check-out, breakfast)

- Two (2) participants may share one (1) room.
- Participants who wish to stay longer than the above period must inform KBF about the itinerary (visiting places & purpose), accommodation information, and an emergency contact during the extended period.
- If you are a vegetarian or wish to require a special diet, please make a detailed description in your registration form.



2) Flight

- KBF will book a round-trip flight ticket (economy class) to/from Incheon International Airport. According to the itinerary of the participants, the KBF will pay up to 70% of the total airfare, and the participant must pay the remaining balance <u>directly to the travel agency's bank account</u>. (Reimbursement of an airfare is not possible. Participants shall not book a flight him/herself.)
- Below is the table showing the maximum amount KBF can pay for each player from different continent.

- All players shall not wear t-shirts, jeans or similar attire during the tournaments and ceremonies.
- The top 3 players and one (1) randomly selected player must accept the anti-doping test.
