4. Competition Events

5. Eligibility

Each Asian country and region may nominate a single team to participate. Each team is limited to one team leader and four players (at least one male player and one female player).

6. Competition Registration

Each team should fill in the registration form as required and submit the registration form, passport data page and player photos to the organizing committee email address: cwainternational@foxmail.com, on or before April 12, 2026

8. Competition Outline

- 1) The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest rules enacted by the Chinese Weiqi Association, with Black giving 3 and 3/4 stones of compensation.
- 2) The online platform is Fox Weiqi, and each player's competition account on the platform will be provided by the organizing committee after the registration period concludes.
- 3) The competition adopts the fixed-player-per-board system. Each team shall have four players (at least one male and one female player). The board positions of the four players must be confirmed prior to the competition, and no changes shall be permitted once the first round commences.
- 4) The Swiss Pairing System will be applied in competitions with a total of seven rounds. The pairings will be generated by computer.
- 5) Each player has 40 minutes basic time, followed by three renewable 30-second overtime periods. Exceeding the time limit shall result in a loss. Lateness of 15 mins or more will be deemed a forfeit; for lateness of less than 15 mins, the late time will be doubled and deducted from the remaining playing time.
- 6) In case of triple ko or other rare situations where a winner cannot be

claimed, the game will be considered drawn.

- 7) For fairness and impartiality, each association is responsible for the organization and online supervision of their teams. Specific requirements will be notified later.

9. Methods for Score Calculation

- 1) 2 game scores will be awarded for a winning game, and 0 for a lost game. 2 round scores will be awarded to the team with higher game scores, 0 for the team with lower game scores, or 1 for teams with the same game scores. An unmatched team will be awarded 2 round scores and 0 game score, and no score will be awarded to the opponent.
- 2) Ranking shall be determined in the following order: the total round scores, total game scores, total team scores of opponents, direct result (for two tied teams only), wins at each table, and the highest-ranked opposing team defeated. If the rankings remain undetermined, they shall be settled by lot.

10. Awards

- 1) The top six teams will be awarded certificates of honor.
- 2) All players will receive a certificate of participation issued by the Chinese Weiqi Association.

11. Any matters not mentioned in these regulations for the competition will be announced separately.
